Robin : It's great listening to someone that is still so enthusiastic about what he does. He inspired me to keep up the good work and to improve more.

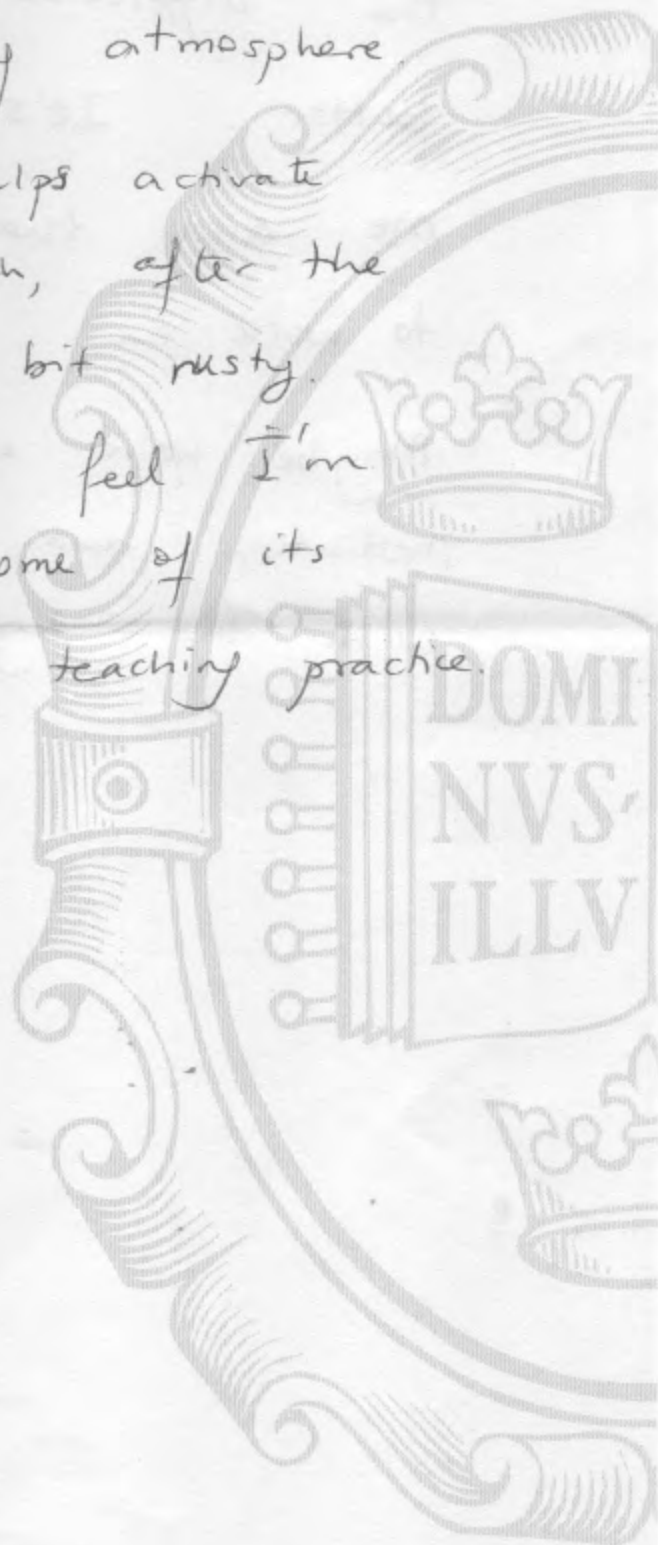
